



RCIA: An Invitation to Come and See!

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is a several month process by which our Church prepares adults for Baptism and the other Sacraments of Initiation - Confirmation and Holy Communion. It is a learning and loving process in which conversion of the heart brings one to Jesus Christ. Also, through weekly meetings, those attending gain a deeper appreciation and understanding of the Catholic beliefs and practices. The RCIA journey begins in the fall, and the process becomes more intense during Lent as candidates prepare for receiving their sacraments at the Easter Vigil. After Easter, we continue to meet and talk about living out our faith. It is up to us to extend a gentle invitation to spouses, relatives, friends and neighbors who may be just waiting for this opportunity. They may be ready but not know how to make an inquiry. Or, they may not be ready today, but you can plant a seed that will grow and bloom into a decision sometime in the future.

Feel free to invite those who may be searching; those who have never been baptized as Christians; those who have been baptized in another Christian faith tradition and are now interested in the Catholic faith; those who were baptized in the Catholic faith but did not receive First Communion and/or Confirmation; and those Catholics who have been away and now may have questions about the Catholic faith. All are welcome, and there is no obligation to make any commitment to become Catholic.
