# Celebrating Easter and Seeking What is Above

Dear Friends,

Happy Easter to all! What a glorious Feast we are able to celebrate! Jesus Christ, the Lamb once slain, has risen from the grave to save us! The second

reading proclaims, "If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God." (Col 3:1) We have been raised with Christ through his cross, and so now we continue to seek what is above in our daily lives.

The resurrection of Christ our Lord is the pinnacle of the entire year of celebrations. #### **Pizza Fundraiser Reminder!**






