## A Message From Father Aaron



### Chosen for the Ministry of Diaconate

Dear Friends,

In Sunday's first reading from the book of Acts we hear about how the first deacons in the early church were selected and ordained. "Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." The deacons of the church were ordained primarily to be ministers of the Word and the Eucharist. They were called to be men of service in the church that serve in unique ways and share their gifts for the sake of building up the Kingdom.

This year, on June 10<sup>th</sup> at St. Mary's Cathedral in St. Cloud, will be the ordination of our own Dan Ruprecht! The Ordination Mass is open to the public and no ticket is needed. If you have the chance, I encourage you to attend, as the ceremony is beautiful! Along with Dan will be Kevin Soenneker, and also Leo Wehseler, who will be ordained a permanent deacon by Bishop Patrick Neary.

Dan and Kevin would be ordained "transitional deacons", as they are on the path of seeking ordination for the priesthood in the summer of 2024. They will serve in the diaconate ministry for just one year. The permanent diaconate, however, (usually a married man) is for a life-long ministry to the diaconate. Deacon Phil Henneman serves in our parishes as a permanent deacon, and I am very grateful for all the great work that he does!

We are very excited for Dan! We have journeyed with and prayed for Dan since he entered the St. Paul Seminary back in the Fall of 2018. Just as the first men were called by name and chosen from the community for this ministry, so was Dan chosen from the community of believers. "The proposal was acceptable to the whole community, so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the Holy Spirit, also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicholas of Antioch, a convert to Judaism. They presented these men to the apostles who prayed and laid hands on them."

Please continue to offer special prayers for Dan, Kevin, Leo and all those who are being ordained deacons and priests this spring and summer. It is a wonderful community of faith celebration! Mark your calendars for June 10<sup>th</sup> at St. Mary's!

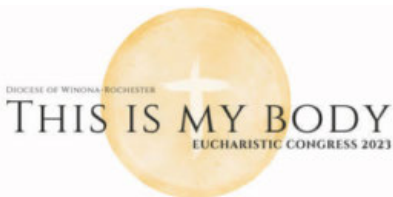
