A Message from Deacon Dan

Praised be Jesus Christ!

I am very grateful for having been ordained a deacon this weekend and am excited to begin this new ministry. I am now what they call a "transitional" deacon. I am a deacon just like Deacon Phil, however, unlike him I have made a promise of celibacy (not to marry) and the Diocese plans to ordain me a priest in the near future (about one year). The grace and charisms I received with my diaconate ordination, however, will remain with me and aid in my ministry later as a priest. The main charism of the deacon is one of service, and this will be the foundation of my ministry as a deacon and later as a priest.

My diaconate ministry will begin this summer with a 10 week assignment in Alexandria. St. Mary's in Alexandria is a large parish, and there are also two smaller parishes, Osakis and Belle River. Father Mathew Kuhn is the pastor, and I will be assisting him in whatever way that I am able. My main diaconate ministry will be preaching homilies, visiting the sick, and baptizing children. I find great joy in telling people about Jesus, and this is what I will get to do no matter what I am involved in this summer. After the summer, I will return to the Saint Paul Seminary for one more academic year, and then be ordained a priest in June of 2024.

It is remarkable to think that five years ago I left my job as a certified public accountant. The time has really gone fast! But I also think about how much change and growth I have experienced from my time in seminary so far. I am much better formed as a person, I have experienced important spiritual growth, and I have learned a lot of important theology. I have been truly blessed these last five years, and I know the main reason it went so well is due to prayers and support from all the faithful. I thank all of you for your prayers. However, the work is not done yet. I will continue to grow and learn as a deacon, and then as a new priest, and then as a pastor, and for the rest of my life. All of our priests and deacons need your support and prayers. Our diocese also needs vocations, and so prayer for more men to enter the seminary is as important now as ever.




