



A Message from Father Aaron The Mission for Souls



Dear Friends,

Today's Gospel from Matthew proclaims the sending of the first Apostles by Jesus out into the world. Jesus said, "As you go, make this proclamation: 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand." The Apostles went out into the pagan

(worship of false gods) territories, hostile crowds and unknown land and gave their lives, literally, for the sake of Kingdom and the mission of the salvation of souls. All twelve of the first Apostles died as martyrs, save St. John, and received the everlasting crown of martyrs in Heaven, the highest celestial reward, dying as Christ our Lord did.

This Gospel is a good reminder for all of us about our purpose on earth as baptized and confirmed Catholics, as we are called to be disciples of Christ. It is especially a good reminder for me, as an ordained priest, that I am primarily called to be a shepherd of souls. Like the prophets in Jesus' day, I know that rejection and criticism are part of the ministry. In fact, if this is not happening, it can be a sign for Christians. For Jesus said, "Woe to you when all speak well of you, for their ancestors treated the false prophets in this way." (Luke 6:26) I would much rather get criticized on earth and win praises in heaven, than the other way around.

I am extremely grateful to God for the opportunity I have had to minister to souls, especially in offering Mass, hearing confessions, offering spiritual direction, praying with and over people, visiting the sick and homebound, baptisms, weddings and funerals, and many other encounters with God's people. In these encounters I have sought to bring Christ to the people, and bring the people to Christ, to the best of my ability.

As I reflect on my time here at St. Anthony's and Assumption parishes, I am so grateful to you all for the opportunity to be your pastor. I have been blessed by your support, prayers and your witness to the Faith. I know that, in being my first assignment as a pastor, I have made mistakes, and so I ask for your forgiveness for the times that I have not lived up to the priest that God called me to be. I am a sinner in need of God's mercy and I ask for your prayers as I continue to strive to be a good and holy priest with all my weaknesses and limitations. However, like St. Paul, I know God meets us most powerfully in our weaknesses, "for whenever I am weak, then I am strong." (2 Cor. 12:10)

May we all strive to be strong disciples of Christ as we receive the graces to live our faith boldly and tell the world about the Good News of salvation in Jesus Christ. We are Christians on a mission for souls, for the the primary soul to be saved is our own.


