



A Final Message from Father Aaron



"Love one another, as I have loved you."
Dear Friends,

Our psalm antiphon today proclaims, "Lord, in your great love, answer me." The psalm proclaims the great love of God and that he hears us and will give us what we

need because of his love for us. God is love, and everything he has given us is out of his love. The greatest act of love God did for us is sacrificing his Son on the cross. "Greater love has no one than to lay down his life for his friends." (John 15:13)

I am so thankful to God for the blessing of getting to know and minister to you here in the parishes of Assumption and St. Anthony's, and beyond. I have known God's love through your care, kindness, dedication, and prayers. Words cannot express my gratitude to you for all you have given to me in these past seven years. You have been a great gift to me. Please know that I will keep you all in my heart and prayers, and I ask that you please keep me in your prayers as well.

As a gift for the parishes, I have ordered an icon of St. Anthony the Great for the parish to hang. It is a beautiful picture and reminder of the patron who dedicated his life to prayer and service to God. For Assumption Church I have given a sign for the narthex area with a quote from John which is the heart of Christ's saving message and parting words to his disciples. Alongside the quote is a picture of the Christ, the Good Shepherd and a crucifix, two symbols of God's love for his people. The scripture quote reads, "I give you a new commandment: love one another, as I have loved you." (John 13:34)

As we go our separate ways may we remember what unites us, no matter where we are, is the love of God. In our prayers, in the scripture, in our good works, and especially in the Holy Eucharist, we are united in God's love for us. St. Paul proclaims what matters most in the end, "So faith, hope, love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love." (1 Cor. 13:13)

Brothers and sisters, we know the one thing that matters most is our relationship with God and our eternal salvation where we are united forever with God and all the faithful. May we always seek to know the great love of God for us, and give that love to others, so one day we may experience fully the love that knows no end in Heaven.




Assumption Mass Ministries






