A Message from Father Aaron

Priest Assignment Change

Dear Friends,



While I was away last week spending some time with friends and family, the priest assignment changes were made for the St. Cloud Diocese and for the current

parish assignment I have. As you know Father Bob Harren made the announcement. I would have liked to be there myself to make this announcement personally, but it didn't work out that way.

The bishop and the personnel board of the St Cloud Diocese has asked me to be the pastor of the St Francis Xavier Area Faith Community starting on June 28th. This ACC includes the parishes of St. Joseph in Pierz, St. Michael in Buckman, St John Nepomuk in Lastrup, and Holy Cross in Harding.

With St. Anthony's parish moving back under the care of the New Ulm Diocese, the Assumption Parish will now be with the St. Nicholas parish and St. Anne's in Kimball. The pastor who has been assigned to these three parishes is Father Don Wagner, who is a wonderful and well-respected priest. Assumption will join the St Augusta ACC which will now consist of six parishes.

I must admit I did not originally expect to be moving locations but as we know, God's ways are not our ways. And so, I said yes, and I place my trust in God's goodness and his divine plan. Although change is a constant part of life, it still does not make it easy. We will do our best to help the parishes and staff transition in the next weeks so that the new arrangements will go well, as we of course place our trust in God's guiding hand.

I am saddened to be leaving these parishes where I have been blessed in so many ways by the Lord and by all of you. It has been a great privilege to be your pastor for these past seven years, and you have been a great gift to me. We will have some time together in the next four weeks to reflect on what God has done in our midst.

But in the meantime, there will be much to do in the next four weeks. And so I ask for your prayers, as I will be praying for you, the staff and the people who I will minister to in the near future. May our good Lord guide us, as he always does, in his ways wisdom, love and peace.




